Completed in 1915, Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is the former home of Goodyear founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Guests from around the world gathered at the estate for family weddings and celebrations. Open to the public for more than 50 years, the Estate includes a 65-room Tudor Revival Manor House and 70 acres of landscaped gardens and grounds, providing a spectacular setting for your special event.

Garden Ceremonies

Special outdoor locations may be reserved for wedding ceremonies. Stan Hywet provides up to 20 chairs for guests who may need to sit during the ceremony. Additional chairs may be rented through advance arrangement with the rentals team. Because the grounds are open to the public a hospitality representative will accompany you at all times.
