### **The Stan Hywet Plant Sale begins May 19**

*Stan Hywet members may shop one day earlier on May 18th*

**April 27, 2018 – Akron, Ohio** –Stan Hywet’s annual **Plant Sale** begins on May 19 at 10am in the Courtyard near Molly’s Shop. A variety of plants including Stan Hywet’s *Homegrown Series* of decorative containers and baskets are available for purchase through June 3rd. Stan Hywet members may purchase plants one day earlier on May 18th by showing their membership card. Molly’s business hours are 10am-5pm, Tuesday through Sunday. The estate is also open on Memorial Day. Stan Hywet is located at 714 North Portage Path, Akron, Ohio.

The plant sale includes a wide array of perennials, grown from cuttings from the historic Great Garden. Annuals, including a large selection of lisianthus, are also for sale.

“Gardeners who purchase from Stan Hywet get the healthiest plants around, while also supporting Stan Hywet, so it’s a win-win,” notes Tom Hrivnak, Superintendent of the estate.

There is no admission to shop at the Plant Sale or at Molly’s Shop & Café, including the outdoor Garden Shop.
