All Moms Receive Free Admission to Stan Hywet on Mother's Day, May 9

April 16, 2021 – Akron, Ohio –Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens will be offering all mothers a complimentary self-guided tour of the Manor House and grounds on Mother's Day, May 9. Accompanying guests pay regular admission prices —\$15 adults, \$6 youth (6-17), children 5 & under, free —which includes a self-guided tour of the historic gardens, the Gate Lodge, Playgarden, and the 65-room Manor House featuring the season exhibit, *Restoration: If This Hall Could Talk*, which is a celebration of the \$6.2 million-dollar restoration on the estate over the last six years.

Molly's Shop is filled with jewelry, apparel and other gifts for mothers, and Molly's Café in the Carriage House Courtyard features salads, sandwiches, beverages and sweets.

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is located at 714 N. Portage Path in Akron, Ohio, and is the former home of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company co-founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Since 1957, it has been a non-profit historic house museum where the public can learn about the cultural, educational, and inspirational riches of one of the most significant achievements in architecture and horticulture to come out of America's Industrial Age. Open April-December, Stan Hywet is the largest historic home in Ohio and the sixth largest in the U.S. Stan Hywet is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and is Akron, Ohio's oldest National Historic Landmark.
