### **Stan Hywet presents Off the Vine: An Evening Pairing of Food and Wine on July 23**

June 30, 2021 – Akron, Ohio - Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens presents **Off the Vine: An Evening Pairing of Food and Wine** from 6-9 pm on Friday, July 23, with reservations required by July 16. After starting the evening with a glass of sparkling wine in a Stan Hywet souvenir wine glass, guests will have the opportunity to enjoy samples of more than three dozen varieties of wine at stations positioned throughout the historic gardens and complemented by tapas-style appetizers by Acme Fresh Market Catering, Driftwood Catering, Taste of Excellence, and Todaro's – with cheese samples from Yellow House Cheese and small desserts by Tiffany's Bakery. Local musicians Hey Mavis; the Tony Koussa, Jr Duo; Siobhan McCarthy; and The Stingers provide music in the gardens throughout the evening. The Manor House with the seasonal exhibit, *Restoration: If This Hall Could Talk*, is open for self-guided tours and the evening is also an opportunity to see *Winds of Change*, the outdoor garden exhibit.

Guests may visit a retail wine pop-up shop open during the event to purchase bottles of their favorite tastings to take home.
