The Stan Hywet Plant Sale begins May 22

Stan Hywet members may shop one day earlier on May 21

May 4, 2021 – Akron, Ohio –Stan Hywet’s annual **Plant Sale** begins on May 22 at 10am in the Courtyard near Molly’s Shop. Plants for sale includes a wide array of perennials, grown from divisions from plants in the historic Great Garden, as well as herbs, cactus and succulents, annuals, including a large selection of lisianthus. Stan Hywet members may shop for plants one day earlier on May 21 and the plant sale ends on June 6.

“Gardeners who purchase annuals and perennials from Stan Hywet get the healthiest plants around, while also supporting Stan Hywet,” notes Tom Hrivnak, Superintendent of the estate.

There is no admission for guests who are shopping at the Plant Sale and/or Molly’s and not taking a tour.

Molly’s is open 10 am-5 pm, Tuesday through Sunday and Memorial Day, May 31. Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is open for tours Tuesday – Sunday and Memorial Day, 10am- 6pm, last entry at 4:30 pm.

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is located at 714 N. Portage Path in Akron, Ohio, and is the former home of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company co-founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Since 1957, it has been a non-profit historic house museum where the public can learn about the cultural, educational, and inspirational riches of one of the most significant achievements in architecture and horticulture to come out of America’s Industrial Age. Open April-December, Stan Hywet is the largest historic home in Ohio and the sixth largest in the U.S. Stan Hywet is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and is Akron, Ohio’s oldest National Historic Landmark.
