58th Annual Father's Day Car Show Includes a Class of Century Cars

New features include music, Model T building and vintage bicycles

May 12, 2015 - Akron, Ohio – One of the oldest car shows in America, the 58th annual *Classic, Antique, & Collector Car Show* at Stan Hywet is Sunday, June 21 from 9am-4:30pm. This annual Father's Day event showcases 400 classic, antique and collector cars manufactured between 1896 and 1990; the *Inner Circle* of notable vehicles from 1940-44; Future Classics (future collectibles) and the Fast Lane area of auto aftermarket vendors. In celebration of Stan Hywet's 100th anniversary, a very special class will feature century cars from 1915 and earlier. Stan Hywet is located at 714 North Portage Path in Akron, Ohio.

New features this year enhance an already full day. The Greater Akron Model T Club will build a Ford Model T, demonstrating how interchangeable parts through mass production were a key to the Industrial Revolution at the beginning of the 20th century. The popular local band, Freez-R-Burn, plays its brand of indie rock 'n' roll throughout the day. The Ohio Wheelmen, a group dedicated to keeping alive the heritage of American cycling and the riding of early bicycles (1918 and earlier) demonstrates how to ride an "Ordinary bicycle." Guests will also have to opportunity to stroll the gardens and enjoy Bloom!, a display of larger-than-life glass sculptures by artist Craig Mitchell Smith. Children and families may enjoy Playgarden, and At Home with Nature: Giant Animal Habitats near the Corbin Conservatory. Scrumptious picnic fare will be available for purchase from Winking Lizard and Molly's Café.

General admission to the Father's Day Car Show is \$14 for adults and \$6 for youth, ages 6-17. Stan Hywet member prices are \$11 for member adults and \$5 for member youth, ages 6-17. Children 5 and under are free. There is no onsite parking at Car Show, but free parking and shuttle service is available throughout the day.
