



Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens Season Opening Postponed

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens will postpone its opening for the season, originally planned for April 1, 2020, as an effort to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 following the recommendations of the CDC, the World Health Organization and Ohio Governor Mike DeWine.

“Ensuring the health and safety of our guests, staff and volunteers is our top priority”, says President & Executive Director Sean M. Joyce. “We will continue to closely monitor the guidance and developments concerning the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and be ready to welcome our guests to the estate once the time is right.”

With the continued uncertainty of the pandemic, an opening date has not been determined at this time. Once the environment surrounding the outbreak becomes clearer, an opening date will be determined and communicated through media resources and the website stanhywet.org.

The decision to delay was made following news reports of more confirmed cases of COVID-19 infection in Northeast Ohio, and as Ohio Governor DeWine announced statewide precautionary measures to contain and mitigate the virus.

Stan Hywet employees were notified of the postponed opening on March 18. Stan Hywet has created a policy to manage certain staff to work from home while providing an environment of separation for those staff needing to be at the estate to care for the property.
