The buffet menu includes a mixed greens salad with candied nuts and cranberries; crumbled blue cheese or fresh shaved parmesan cheese, dressed with house-aged balsamic vinaigrette or white French dressing; assorted rolls & butter; herb roasted chicken breast stuffed with dried fruits finished with a thyme cream sauce; chef-carved ham with assorted mustards, fresh green beans, and garlic mashed potatoes. A dessert station features tiramisu, caramel apple pie, New York style cheesecake and chocolate mousse cake; the beverage station includes coffee, hot tea and hot chocolate.
