BIRDING ADVENTURES

Learn how to use your eyes and ears to discover a variety of birds in your own backyard by first learning how to identify common birds by sight and sound at Stan Hywet.



BUTTERFLIES IN BLOOM

(available starting June 16) Explore Stan Hywet's landscape and discover the importance of butterflies and pollinators to the gardens and grounds. Kids will explore the grounds to find an array of butterfly and pollinator species that call Stan Hywet home, then have an opportunity to feed a real butterfly in our butterfly habitat.



HAWKS, FOX, AND DEER, OH MY!

A Habitat Exploration Discover what animals need to survive and learn how Stan Hywet's landscape architect used the existing land to create the unique spaces that a variety of animals today call home.



NATURE PHOTOGRAPHY

Explore photography as a form of art through a variety of photographs taken by Willard Seiberling. Then, experiment with how you can use photography to capture plants and animals in the unique gardens and around historic structures. Discover "Questing," a low-tech treasure hunt game using clues and rhymes to uncover overlooked features, locations and unique stories about the Seiberling family and their estate.



INTRO TO GEOCACHING

Explore the hidden treasures of Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens while learning about geocaching, a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Geocaching combines outdoor play with team-building and problem-solving; join us to try your hand at Geocaching and discover Stan Hywet's magnificent grounds. NOOKS & BOOKS
