he 2021 season, *Restoration: If This Hall Could Talk*, celebrated the extensive restoration projects that had been completed throughout the estate since 2015. Stan Hywet shared the impressive results of the restored Manor House interiors and the many exterior projects completed with funds raised in the 2nd Century Campaign in 2015. In the gardens, *Winds of Change*, presented by Peg's Foundation, was featured for a second year. Unique, colorful sculptures created by women artists incorporated a kinetic component, using wind or motion as a core element of the design.

### DEAR FRIENDS,

hen Stan Hywet opened on April 1, 2021, for the season, there was hope for a normal season – along with trepidation after the tumultuous year of 2020. We had a strong season planned with the theme of *Restoration:* If This Hall Could Talk, a celebration of the extensive restoration projects completed throughout the estate since 2015, funded by the successful \$6 million 2nd Century Campaign of 2015. Masks and safety protocols remained in place, but by June, guided tours were back on the roster and masks were optional.

Then the pandemic and another surge in COVID-19 cases threw us a curve ball. Following local and national guidelines, guided tours were once again put on hiatus and on August 17, masks were again required in all indoor spaces.

Despite these challenges, the extraordinary Manor House exhibit launched a very successful year in various aspects resulting in record visitation of 149,769 guests. Guests returned to the estate to enjoy a complete calendar of public programs. Ohio Mart recorded its highest attendance in six years, 18% more than the previous Ohio Mart (2019); and attendance for Deck the Hall was just shy of the record set in 2018.

The rentals team had a very busy season with 221 events, including 80 weddings (some that had been postponed from 2020) and 75 life celebrations. We are proud that so many chose Stan Hywet for their special life celebrations. More than 7,200 students, young children and adults benefitted from in-person and virtual programming orchestrated by our education team — learning about the history of Stan Hywet or using the estate as a "lab" for a variety of topics.

We are proud of and thankful for our staff and volunteers and their commitment and efforts at Stan Hywet. It is particularly rewarding for Stan Hywet to receive accolades from our peers that validate Stan Hywet's excellence. The book. The Manor House, a companion to the 2021 exhibit. received the Gold Award in visual communications from the Ohio Museums Association; and The Vault, our popular video history series for members received the Silver Award in the same class. Our popular murder mystery program, Murder in the Mansion, was selected as the 2021 Outstanding Interpretive Program by the National Association for Interpretation, Great Lakes Region. All of these accomplishments are attributable to the talented and passionate staff and volunteers at Stan Hywet. When you are on the grounds at Stan Hywet, please take a moment to express your appreciation to our volunteers and staff members.

Donors to the 2nd Century Campaign were honored for their generosity at a reception on the estate on a beautiful September evening. Donors also contributed generously to Stan Hywet's Annual Fund, which increased by 13% in 2021, the largest increase since 1998. We are grateful for and humbled by our donors and the support that we receive from them, accentuating our work to preserve and share our historic estate and serve as a resource for educational, cultural, and recreational enrichment.

Thank you to our staff, volunteers, donors, and guests for supporting us in 2021. We are excited for each of you to discover the unique and remarkable experiences Stan Hywet offers for you in our 2022 season. We look forward your continued support and to seeing you on the estate soon.

### RECORD ATTENDANCE

Stan Hywet's very successful 2021 season, *Restoration: If This Hall Could Talk,* brought record visitation of 149,769 guests to the estate, an 18% increase over 2019. The season ended on a high note when 41,622 guests enjoyed Deck the Hall decorated for *Lights, Cameras, Christmas.* Attendance at Deck the Hall was just shy of the record set in 2018.

### RESTORATION **CELEBRATION**

The generous donors to the 2nd Century Campaign were invited to explore the completed restoration work on September 16 at a reception on a beautiful late summer evening. Two hundred guests enjoyed the estate and were celebrated for their thoughtful support.





### RESTORATION BOOK

Stan Hywet published its sixth book in a series on the history of the Seiberling family and Stan Hywet. The Manor House focuses on restoration projects completed since 2015. This book won the Gold Award in visual communications from the Ohio Museums Association in 2022.

Stan Hywet began a multi-year, capital improvement project in 2021 to raise funds for additional guest parking as well as facility upgrades — including a new volunteer resource center and a new service center for the horticulture department. Total project cost is \$3,182,825. Stan Hywet plans to raise \$1,882,825, with a match from the State of Ohio of \$1,300,000.

### **RESTORATION PROJECTS**

Virginia's Bedroom was one of the last spaces to be restored in the sixyear restoration of the Manor House interiors. The result was one of the most dramatic. After a remnant of the original wallpaper of gold fleur-de-lis over a crackled background pattern was discovered in the archives, it was reproduced and installed. The wall sconces were restored, complete with recreated pink silk shades, and the bedroom now looks just like the one that 16-year-old Virginia Seiberling enjoyed.

One of two 16th century tapestries in the Great Hall, Rebecca at the Well, was shipped in July 2021 to Museum Textile Services in Andover, Massachusetts, a company that specializes in restoring and preserving tapestries. The tapestry is due to return in October 2022.

### WALK THROUGH TIME PANELS

The Picturing the Past panels on the estate were redesigned to include interactive elements and renamed Walk through Time. They were installed in 2021, and the panels also include a family-friendly scavenger hunt that connects to Joe's Adventure Guide, an eight-page activity guide available in Admissions.

### **GATE LODGE PIANO**






After the restored Gate Lodge reopened in August 2020 with a new exhibit, Henrietta Seiberling: A Spark for a Movement, the one item that was missing from the living room was a piano. Buying a piano had not been part of the original restoration plan because of the expense. However, with the research help and funding from an anonymous donor, a new Knobe-Baltimore piano was purchased, built using a historic design. This old-looking new piano also has a digital component, preloaded with classical music pieces that functions like a player piano. The piano was delivered in January 2021.

REFLECTIONS DATABASE

Many Founders' Day guests visit the Reflections Tent, where they record on paper their own thoughts about their recovery and sobriety. These binders have been collected by Stan Hywet since 2004 and in 2021, the Collections team and volunteers transcribed over 2,100 heartwarming reflections into the Reflections Database, a searchable database organized into categories by content, with anonymity preserved.

Stan Hywet received several honors in 2021, acknowledgements of the dedicated work of our staff and volunteers.



MURDER IN THE MANSION

The popular whodunit public program, Murder in the Mansion, was selected as the 2021 Outstanding Interpretive Program by the National Association for Interpretation, Great Lakes Region. The nomination submitted for "Murder" acknowledged the cumulative efforts of Stan Hywet's staff and volunteer actors since the program's inception in 2008, and recognized the creativity and versatility necessary to provide a successful virtual experience to guests in 2020 during the pandemic.

The award was presented in late March 2021, during the virtual Regional Interpreters' Workshop. The Stan Hywet Historic Players filmed an acceptance video that was played during the awards presentation, and a plaque was received later in the spring for display at Stan Hywet.



### THE MANOR HOUSE BOOK AND THE VAULT

Stan Hywet was awarded the top two 2021 Visual Communications Awards in its category, budget level 5 (\$1 to \$5 million) from the Ohio Museums Association. The book, *The Manor House*, won the Gold Award. Published in September 2021, *The Manor House* is the most recent book in a series on Stan Hywet and the Seiberling family.



The Vault: Stan Hywet Revealed, won the Silver Award. A popular video history series emailed regularly to Stan Hywet members, each episode explores a history snippet about Stan Hywet history and the Seiberling family.
